FASH Chat – Hip-Hop meets Folk Dance

Fresh from their sell-out performances of The Lock In 'Christmas Carol' the *Breaking Tradition* dance company returns to Ye Olde Fighting Cocks for a comical new version of their critically acclaimed Folk & Hip Hop dance show, suitable for all the family.

With music provided by *The Demon Barbers* (BBC Radio 2 Folk Awards Winners of 'Best Live Act') they bring some of the UK's oldest forms of dance bang up to date with some of the youngest, in a high energy celebration of dance culture.

Combining elements from Grimms' classic fairy tales with a strongly rhythmic musical score and colourful new choreography, The Lock In 'Folk Fairy Tale' promises to be one of the most exciting dance theatre events of the year.

The Show is coming to The Theatre Royal at Winchester on Wednesday the 28th of March. Don't miss it!

The Story goes:

A group of hip-hop dancers arrive at an apparently deserted pub but local rumour has it that this tumble-down inn is frequented by 'other worldly' characters and as the regulars arrive, a clash of cultures soon turns into a dance floor stand-off.

While fusion-loving landlady, Grandma, is nowhere to be seen, the pub is being run by the stubborn, and mysteriously lupine, Jasmine, who is determined to stamp out the fun and keep things strictly traditional.

There is hope, though, in the form of a mystical woodcutter who may just have some tricks up his chequered sleeve. Will the woodcutter succeed? Can the regulars get the party started? Will we ever know what happened to Grandma?

This duo have been awarded funding through the English Folk Song and Dance Society's 'Creative Seed Programme', which they aim to spend on researching and developing their second EP exploring country and city themes. The concert, on the 17th February, starts at 8.00. Ticket purchase is via the website, but it is not immediately obvious how to get to the right page. The next folk concert in the series is in April, on 14th, when Emily Smith and Jamie McClennan are on stage.

As we were about to 'go to press' we were saddened to hear of the death of Brian Hammond on 9th January. Brian was probably better known in the east of Hampshire where he played accordion for several organisations including Fishbourne Mill Morris, Devil's Jumps clog dancers and the Emsworth Folk Dance Club.

Aged 86, Brian had recovered from a major injury to his left shoulder and was able to play his favourite instrument again. He was recently diagnosed with an inoperable aneurism, and collapsed with his accordion strapped on, just

about to play for Fishbourne Mill Morris at a public event – most musicians would agree that if it is ‘time to go’, while you are doing what you love best is the right time. Our condolences go to his wife Barbara and the family.

Finally, I must remind you of our second FASH workshop in February. On the 25th, in what has now become an annual event, The Madding Crowd join us at Soberton Village Hall

for a day of singing, playing and general harmonising (or even just listening) under the principal direction of Mike Bailey.
