The A.G.M. on 10th May was well attended, and thank you to those who turned up to support the Committee. It is heartening to see or get support, and makes a good feeling that we are getting it right - some of the time.

The financial position is still healthy, with thanks to Una Boulton and Contactaband, who support FASH with funds throughout the year. However, there was a slight loss overall, due very largely to the disaster over the New Year Dance. Not because the Band and Callers couldn't make it, but mainly the extremely cold frosty weather and the dreaded 'flu that went round in the winter. Some of the other events made a profit, and helped to offset this loss, so FASH was able to remain reasonably solvent.

Ian announced at the A.G.M. that he was standing down as Chairman, he took over in 1990 to fill in, and has been hard at it ever since. He was instrumental in getting FASH off the ground, with help from Syd Wilkins, in 1994, when EFDSS decided to restructure the Society. Then was able to see it rise from the ashes of EFDSS South Hants, to become a thriving Folk Association for South Hants. I am sure he was going to tell you all this himself, but unfortunately has been laid low.

The rest of the Committee thank him for all his work, forbearance with us all, and commitment to the area. He has made a really good Chairman, keeping us all in some sort of order, with a velvet glove. He indicated he would stay on the committee, so we shall not lose his support altogether.

At the next Committee meeting hopefully a new Chair will be appointed, and there will be continuity within the Association. A full programme of events is planned, and mostly booked, so watch this space - as they say. In fact, watch all space in this issue, else the format of Solent Waves will change dramatically!!!

At the A.G.M. on the 10th May, it became apparent that our indefatigable Editors of Solent Waves were somewhat disheartened. Is it because some Clubs/Teams cannot be bothered to write or lift the phone to let them know? Or, is it just the usual apathy of cannot be bothered?

After all the pleas to let the Editors know what was on on May Day, i.e. 1st May NOT the Bank Holiday, there was little or no news of anything going on. Yet I am sure Morris Men danced at the Bargate in Southampton, and I know Morris Men/Women danced in Wickham Square, to say nothing of all the other things that happened on 1st May. The Wickham Square evening was superb, with children dancing round a Maypole, and around 14 teams dancing in turn, until 9.30pm.

Also, there has just been the upset of Neil Goulbourn dying in China, and of the three numbers rang to contact some-one about it, not one of them was correct! SO WHY DO FASH PRINT THE BACK PAGE MONTH AFTER MONTH?

Even if your present contact number is correct CONFIRM IT.

It has been published for nearly 20 years due to great effort in the beginning by Pete Chadbund, and then other Editors and finally Peter and Elizabeth, who have done it for 14 years. A marathon I think you will all agree. I am sure the support is out there somewhere - tho' where just this minute, I am not sure.

The Committee were heartened by the good number of people attending the A.G.M. to support and encourage FASH.

To those of you who could not make it to the A.G.M., but would like to see Solent Waves carry on and put your Display Teams on the back page, DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT NOW AND SHOW SUPPORT FOR A VERY WORTHWHILE NEWSLETTER.

WINCHESTER FOLK FESTIVAL - 18th - 20th April 1997

It's always sunny and warm at Winchester Folk Festival but not this year! The weekend started with spots of rain, the first for weeks which didn't bode well for the 20+ display sides, craft fair and other outdoor events but then the sun weakly put in an appearance, the committee started to shed their thermal undergarments and the weekend took on an altogether more optimistic complexion.

The first event of the Festival was a children's Country Dance Festival at Riverpark Leisure Centre involving children from 6 local schools, the culmination of weeks of hard work by Carolyn Robson, the teachers and of course the children. The project was sponsored by Winchester City Council, and it has been awarded a lottery grant to extend its work over the next year, to involve more schools and many more children. Other events for children over the weekend included a Maypole Workshop, a Morris Minors Workshop with Nick Walden and a Making Flying Objects Workshop with Dave Williams - thanks to FASH for their contribution towards the cost of these events.

Over the last few years we have experimented with different events on the Friday Night of the Festival - a Cajun dance, concerts at various venues etc., but this year we seemed to hit the jackpot - 2 events in the Guildhall - a concert headlined by Tim Laycock, and a dance with the Bursledon Village Band and Gordon Potts. Gordon also gets the prize for the most novel way to draw raffle tickets - keep throwing them on the floor until you've only got 4 tickets left! Saturday Night was also a sell-out with a concert and two very different, but both enjoyable dances - the last Guildhall Barn Dance of the season with Nigel Close and Pendragon, and the Festival Ceilidh with the 10+ strong Committee Band.

I could go on, and review the Traditional Hymn Sing (back after a 15 year absence), the American music extravaganza at the North Pole Cafe, the line-dancing workshops (both Western and Eastern European) but I don't think the editors would be very happy if I took over the WHOLE of Solent Waves!

Thanks to all the local dance teams, musicians, singers, callers and stewards who contributed to the success of the 1997 Winchester Folk Festival. Next year's Festival is 24th - 26th April.
