If you enjoy Carol concerts, then there's a very enjoyable event at Cecil Sharp House on Sunday 20th December. There's an afternoon dance from 2pm and then the concert in the evening from about 7pm. Hilary and I have been for the last 2 years and really enjoyed it.

Talking about events in the future, I shall be leading a workshop entitled 'Fun with Challenging Dances' on Sunday 10th January 1999. The programme will contain a mixture of dance styles from Playford to New England Contras but the emphasis will be on Fun and working as a team. 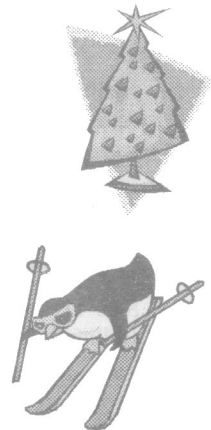

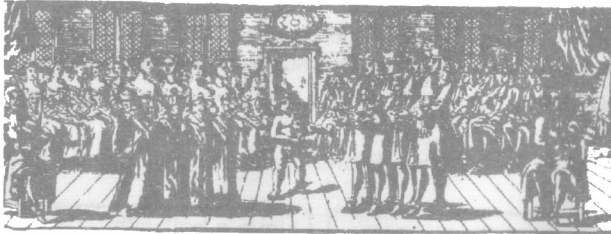
