

## Directions to Soberton Village Hall

From the East:

Take the M27 and leave at junction 10

From where the slip road joins the A32, continue north, taking the second exit on each of the two roundabouts, signposted "Alton".

As you approach Droxford, a little past the 40 mph restriction sign, look out for a small road on the right (Cutts Arch) signposted "Soberton" and the "White Lion PH". This is a narrow road so take care along it, especially on the two sharp bends and the hump-back bridge.

At the end of this road, turn right, past the White Lion pub, to a crossroads. Turn left here (Long Road) and immediately left into the hall car park.

(If you are reluctant to drive along the narrow Cutts Arch, continue north through Droxford and as you leave the village turn right onto the B2150, signposted "Denmead".

\*\*Pass under the railway bridge and turn right into Station Road. At the crossroads in Soberton turn left and immediately left into the car park.)

From the West:

On the M27, until junction 10 has been reworked to an all directions interchange, continue east to leave at junction 11. Go right round the roundabout and rejoin the M27 heading west. Leave at the next junction, which is junction 10, and follow the instructions for travelling from the east.

From the North via the M3 or the A34.

The simplest route is to continue onto the M27, heading towards Portsmouth (east), and following the instructions from the west, above.

If you would prefer a more scenic route, or to save a few miles, leave the M3 at junction 9 (from the A34 take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit on the roundabout) and follow the A272 south. At the next roundabout take the second exit towards Eastleigh.

Continue south, paralleling the motorway, and at the next roundabout take the first exit, towards Morestead and Corhampton. Look out for a turning on the left (Morestead Road) signposted "Morestead, Corhampton"

Follow this road to its end and turn left to Corhampton.

At the roundabout in Corhampton turn right, south along the A32, and as you approach Droxford turn left into the A2150. Follow the instructions at \*\* above.
