# FASH Chat – Winchester Mayfest 2018

Rocking Your Boat? Come Winchester Mayfest on 19 May 2018

There will be dancing and music in the streets of Winchester, bringing the centre alive for your enjoyment!

At this stage, many details have yet to be finalised; however, we anticipate some 25 or so dance sides taking part in locations across the City Centre and in the Cathedral grounds. And this year, apart from coinciding with the Mayfest, the football and the Royal Wedding, the Cathedral will be hosting Pentecostal celebrations and a big screen broadcast of the wedding, and means that as well as our Morris displays there will be other family entertainment going on around the Cathedral during the afternoon, all adding to the fun.

The central locations such as the Buttercross. High Street and Museum Square will host daylong dancing. The covered area known as St Maurice's Covert will be used for Appalachian dancing while the beautiful little St Lawrence's Church welcomes Southampton the Folk Orchestra and the Hampshire Youth Folk Ensemble.

We will have displays of various styles of Morris dancing from the different traditions found across England - Cotswold, Border and North West clog. Within each style there are traditional dances from different villages and communities so there will be plenty of variety; it

There will also be Stave dancing and Rapper sword dancing, again English in origin but quite different to Morris dancing. We will also have several Appalachian dance sides with their exciting music and energetic stepping. Wherever the dances originated in this country, or in America in the case Appalachian, all our visiting dance sides have come from no more than 30 miles away from Winchester.

> As well as ongoing performances throughout the day, most sides will take part in the Mayor's Show, a 90-minute spectacle performed for the Mayor, with each side performing one show dance. This will be followed by a mass audience participation dance led by Wickham Morris and not to be missed. There will also be other opportunities during the day to join in with various sides and have a go yourselves!

> There will be no evening music session or ceilidh this year as the venue is not available, but during gaps between performances during the day musicians and singers from the dance sides often start impromptu sessions in the some of the city centre pubs, so do look out for these and join in or just listen.

> VOLUNTEERS NEEDED to help in the various venues on the day - mainly making sure the performers are there and spectators and passers-by give them room to dance. Please contact Kathie Knell (kathie@brockhole.com) or Lin Rayner

And then they were gone! It is almost a shock to find that the dance diary has suddenly shrunk, with the simultaneous ending of the ceilidh and workshop 'seasons'. After April there are no more SHOCC Ceilidhs, Twyford Ceilidhs, the more recently added Kimmeridge Keilidhs, FASH workshops or SusFA workshops at Pulborough until autumn.

To balance, we are going into the festivals season. Most folk festivals, and many festivals which do not have 'folk' in their titles, include ceilidhs and often dance workshops in their programmes. Some, such as Eastbourne and Litchfield, are dance festivals, with no concerts or music sessions. So keep dancing – there is still plenty going on.

There is, however, one more dance this month organised by FASH, and that is the one following our AGM. The AGM is on the 20th May, the day following the Mayfest, and will be at Soberton Village Hall, starting at 4.00. We do not expect it to last even as long as an hour, so the now traditional cream tea will be available at around 5.00, to be followed by a dance at about 6.00 until 8.30. This year our caller is Ian Kirby who will be familiar to the many of you who attend the Twyford Ceilidhs. He is supported with music from Pete and Sue Hall. Although we would be delighted to see as many people as possible at the AGM, attendance at the meeting is not a requirement to come along to the dance. Prices are unchanged this year, with cream teas at £2.50 and the dance at £4.00. If you renew your FASH membership at the AGM and decide to buy a workshops season ticket at £40 (includes membership), it will also include entry for this year's AGM dance. What a huge range of styles and traditions are represented here. Many sides dance well-known dances which were only actually recorded/documented at the beginning of last century, even though they were regularly danced hundreds of years, certainly in the 16th century, before that. A number of sides perform dances they have written themselves, some even dancing to music penned by members of the side. Others have a mixture of dances, traditional and new, that they have been practising all winter, ready to perform when they dance out in the warmer weather.

Fortunately most of our local sides publish their programmes on-line, and we have collected these together to provide what is probably the most complete single diary of what our display teams are doing, on-line on the FASH website.
